Core Principle

We accept professional responsibility for our individual decisions and actions. We are also advocates for Umpqua Valley Winegrowers by engaging in activities that enhance its credibility and value.

Intent

This shall be done in only extreme situations and with overwhelming proof. Shall it be necessary to remove a member, this action may only be possible by a unanimous vote of the entire board.
